



Aiming High for Disabled Children & Young People in Sandwell

Buddy Scheme & One to One Support

In partnership with children and young people, their families and carers, Core Children's Services is committed to offering quality support services to help disabled children and young people to live independent, full and dignified lives.

In Sandwell we can offer funded spaces on our 1:1 buddy scheme. Activities can take place at a venue chosen by the child and family and may include activities at home, trips to clubs such as scouts or brownies, trips to the park, swimming, tennis or dancing. The support is entirely flexible and any activity can be chosen subject to the child's wishes and feelings and a detailed risk assessment undertaken. Families are just required to pay the cost of any activities. This service is available for children and young people aged 0 -18.

Children will be supported by a team of workers who are both qualified and experienced along with having enhanced criminal records checks in place.
